

Übungen zu Simple Present / Present Progressive (Lösungen)

1.1 Put in the following verbs:

Tina must go to the supermarket today. She **takes** the list from the table in the kitchen and **looks** at it. There are only three things on it, but Popstars is on TV – she always **watches** that. She **goes** to the shop and **buys** a packet of biscuits and a bottle of orange juice. After that she **sees** Laura. They **go** back home together. Tina is happy because now she can watch Popstars. She **puts** the bag on the kitchen floor. The orange juice and the biscuits are all over the floor. Poor Tina – now she can't **watch** TV. She must tidy up the kitchen.
